We have had an exciting week back already.

Dear Parent/Carer,

Our after school clubs will commence the week beginning Monday 8<sup>th</sup> May. All clubs run for 6 weeks. No clubs during half-term.

You must only book **one club** in the first instance. **If you book more than one you will be refunded for both clubs and have to wait.** You will not be able to rebook the same club from a previous term. After 24 hours of the go-live date, you may book more than one club, or a club from a previous term.

If your child is in receipt of benefits-related free school meals (i.e. receives supermarket vouchers in the holidays) they will be entitled to one free club.

**Please note the online booking process:**

- ParentPay account must be activated in order to book
- Booking system live from **Monday 24<sup>th</sup> April (4.45pm)**
- Log-in to [www.parentpay.com](http://www.parentpay.com) - book and pay for preferred club
- Clubs offered on a first-come, first-served basis
- Booking system closes at midnight on Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> May.

Clubs are non-refundable. Once the allocated places have been taken, the clubs will no longer appear as available in your ParentPay account. We suggest that you act promptly to avoid disappointment. Some clubs sell out within minutes.
