

# Autumn 1 Homework

This is a list of activities for you to choose and enjoy doing with your child. Choose one activity a week. You do not have to do all of the activities or in a specific order.

## History

- Create a timeline of your life. E.g. baby, toddler, child. You could stick pictures or draw pictures.
- Draw a picture of a celebration that you have celebrated e.g. Christmas, Easter, Eid. Write what you did to celebrate.

## Geography

- Draw a map of a room in your house. Make sure you put the objects in the correct places.

## Science:

- Look around your house or outside for different objects. Draw the object and write what material it is made of. E.g. a chair is made of wood, a pencil is made of wood.

## Art:

- Paint a picture of an object you have found e.g. a chair, a book, a flower. Use your colour mixing skills to create the painting!

## Maths

- Collect objects (up to 20). Count how many you have got. Take a picture and stick it in. Write your numbers carefully.
- Pick a number (0-20). Find 1 more than the number. E.g. 1 more than 14 is 15.
- Pick a number (0-20). Find 1 less than the number. E.g. 1 less than 10 is 9.

## Practise reading and spelling tricky words (write them carefully in your homework book):
