

Science

Identify a variety of plants and animals in their habitats and micro-habitats.

Find out about and describe the basic needs of animals and humans for survival.

Ask simple questions.

Perform simple tests.

Notice that animals, including humans, have offspring that grow into adults.

PE

Multi-skills: Ball skills including throwing catching and dribbling. Skills such as skipping, jumping and hopping.

Art and Design

Use sculpture and designs to develop and share their ideas, experiences and imagination.

Geography

Use simple fieldwork and observational skills to study the geography of the school and its grounds.

Use and read keys in maps.

Design and Technology

Design purposeful, functional, appealing products for themselves and other users based on design criteria.

Writing

Write down new ideas including new vocabulary. Write for different purposes.

Fiction writing—writing our own version of Anansi and Turtle, character descriptions.

Non-fiction writing—recount, instructions and fact files.
