

Homework - Spring 1



This term our topic is Coastline. We are learning about coastlines, Whitby and the UK.

Please try and do one activity a week with your child.

- Search the web or non-fiction books to find out about a famous boat or ship. Make an information book by writing down interesting facts and where it travelled to. Make a drawing. Famous ships to choose from could include, the Endeavour, the Santa Maria, the Piñta, Titanic, or the Cutty Sark.
- Design and make a boat that floats. Investigate a range of every day materials. What
 materials will you use? What will be waterproof? How could you change the shape of
 the material so it floats?
- Visit your local library to read and borrow a story and information books about the sea. Write a book review about your favourite.
- Make a map of your favourite holiday destination to show all the main features.
 Include physical landmarks such as beaches, hills or forests, as well as human features such as shops, farms or harbours. Where would be a good place to hide treasure? Can you plot a route to find it?
- Use every day 3D shapes to make an object. Label the properties' of the object. For example, 12 square faces, 16 vertices, 24 edges,
- When you go shopping look at the price tag of items. Make the exact amount for it. for example: bread 89p For example: 50p, 20p, 10p 5p 2p and 1p.
- With your family, make up the cost of different items as in breakfast costs 50p,
 dinner costs 95p and snacks are 69p each.
- Find a simple cake recipe and practise measuring the ingredients using g (grams) and ml (millilitres). Then, make the cake!
