

Homework Spring 2

Please try and do one activity a week with your child.

Maths:

- Create a tally chart of different plants. Go on a plant walk in your garden or at the park and tally how many of them you see.
- Practise your multiplication \ division e.g. $\div 20$ $5 = 4$
- Go on a 2D and 3D shape hunt around your house. What shapes can you find?
- Collect different objects from around your house. Count how many you have. See if you can find half of the number of objects (make two groups). Can you find $\frac{1}{4}$? $\frac{2}{4}$? $\frac{3}{4}$? Try finding $\frac{1}{3}$!
- Measure different plants at the park or in your garden. Put them in order from shortest to longest.

Topic:

- Measure different plants at the park or in your garden. Put them in order from shortest to longest.
- Investigate the works of Artist Georgia O'Keefe
- Sketch a flower or a piece of fruit showing its seeds.
- Create a collage picture of a flower or plants.
- Plant a seed and observe its growth. Record what you see happening as time goes on.
- Make up your own version of Jack and the Beanstalk – maybe you could change the characters names, where they are/where they live.

Spellings:

Go through the 100 and 200 high frequency words that were given out at parents evening. Practise the ones that you find the trickiest! See if you can write them into a sentence!
