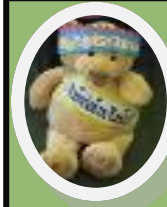

### Scooters, Bikes and School Car Park

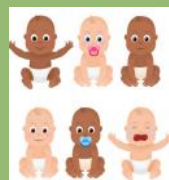
