Online Safety Corner – Spring 1

YouTube & Video Apps: What’s Really Showing?

Many children love watching videos online—but even apps made for kids, like **YouTube Kids**, can sometimes show **inappropriate or confusing content**.

Avoid unsupervised use of:

- **YouTube (main app)** – Includes ads, pranks, scary stories, and adult content
- **YouTube Shorts** – Quick videos with loud sounds and unpredictable content
- **TikTok** – Not suitable for under 13s, even when “just watching”

Common issues:

- **Autoplay** can show strange or scary videos next
- **Ads** might push toys, games, or junk food
- **Parodies** or fan-made animations may confuse or frighten children

Safer options:

- **YouTube Kids** – Use with supervision, turn off autoplay, and block videos if needed
- **BBC iPlayer (CBeebies section)** – Trusted and age-appropriate
- **Netflix Kids** – With a child profile and set viewing restrictions
- **StoryToys** or **Bini ABC** – Video + interactive learning

Parent Tip:

Use “Download for Offline” features to pre-select safe shows without ads. Watch together and talk about what your child sees

What Is In-App Chat? Why It’s Risky for Ages 3–7

Many games and apps let players **chat or message each other** while playing. But for young children, this can be unsafe.

Polite Reminder – Parking

Illness & Attendance Update

As part of our ongoing work to tighten attendance procedures and keep our school community safe, we are making a small but important change to our illness guidance.

Previously, children were asked to remain at home for 24 hours after vomiting. **Following NHS guidance, this has now changed to 48 hours.**

If your child has **vomiting or diarrhoea**, they must not attend school and should only return **48 hours after the last episode**. If a child becomes unwell during the school day because of either of these, parents/carers will be contacted to collect them, and the 48-hour period will begin from that time.

Absences due to illness will continue to be recorded as authorised. This change helps reduce the spread of infection and supports good attendance by keeping children well in school.
