## Whole School Attendance – 97.2%

The children have settled well and it has been great to see them enjoying their learning across the school.

We are really pleased to share that attendance has improved this week and is currently **97.2%**, which is well above our school target of **96%**. Well done everyone! We know how important regular attendance is in helping children to make strong progress, build confidence, maintain friendships and feel settled in school. Thank you to all parents and carers for your continued support in ensuring children arrive at school on time each day.

This week, our Year 1 children, along with some children in Year 2, have completed the phonics screening check. The children approached this calmly and tried their very best, and we are very proud of them. Thank you to parents and carers for continuing to support reading and phonics practice at home — regular reading makes such a difference to children's confidence and progress.

As we move through this final half term, there are lots of exciting events coming up, including transition activities, visits, sports events and end-of-year celebrations. Please do take a look at the school calendar so that you are aware of key dates and arrangements.
